

MTW Extended Day

Medical Forms

For Children Who Have Severe Chronic Health Issues

1. Ext Day Health Action Plan

(required)

2. Asthma Form

(required if your child has chronic asthma requiring a pump on site)

3. Allergies / Anaphylaxis Form

(required if your child has chronic food allergies causing anaphylaxis requiring an EpiPen on site)

4. General Medication Form

(This form is required if other more general medications are necessary)

NOTE: The Asthma & Allergy/Anaphylaxis forms are the same given to the MTW nurse. Ext Day will copy and forward to the nurse's office.

Asthma pumps and EpiPens must be delivered to the Ext Day office or the nurse's office by the first day of school. All medication and forms must be kept up to date or your child will not be allowed to attend Ext Day.

All forms and medication must be given to Ext Day before your child can begin the program.
